The Slovenian School Museum is one of the oldest museums in Slovenia, founded in 1898. The idea for the museum came from Jakob Dimnik, a primary school teacher from Ljubljana.
Their1 are fun and interesting, but what sets it apart from other museums is the chance to step back in time and attend a class in a strict primary school of the Austro-Hungarian Empire.
Adults, too, will find it intriguing; maybe you will find something that you had to use in school and can share the memory with your family. We loved seeing old photographs, notebooks, annual school2 and old desks, chairs and blackboards.
Try a turn-of-the-20th-century lesson
If you want a different experience, something that will stay with you long after you have gone3, you should enrol in class and experience first-hand what primary school was like in the Austro-Hungarian Empire, which Slovenia was once part of. The goal of the class, taught in English, is for4 to get to know the importance of discipline and tidiness, learn where the name Ljubljana originates from, discuss Slovenian5 France Prešeren and his poem "A Toast" (the Slovenian national anthem), and learn how to count from one to ten in Slovenian.

- A The small number of people speaking Slovene makes it almost a secret language. It is a native language to approximately 2.1 million people. It is also spoken by Slovenian minorities in the bordering countries of Italy, Croatia, Hungary, and Austria, and Slovenian immigrants in the USA, Argentina, Serbia, Canada, Australia and South Africa.
- B Slovene is one of the rare Indo-European languages which still uses a dual form. It is also the only official language of the European Union that uses a dual form. The dual form is used when referring to exactly two people, objects or concepts.
- C The modern Slovene alphabet was developed in the 1840s. It contains 25 letters. The alphabet uses the basic Latin alphabet with the added letters Č, Š, Ž. The alphabet does not use X and Y.
- D When Slovenians use traditional curse words it sounds more silly than offensive. Perhaps the most popular curses in Slovene are "Tristo kosmatih medvedov" (Three hundred hairy bears), "Naj te koklja brcne!" (A hen should kick you!), and "Krščen matiček!" (Baptised Matthew!).
- E During WWII Slovenia was occupied by Germans, Italians, Hungarians, and Croatians. With the Occupation came a ban on using Slovene in schools. If caught speaking their native language in school, students were beaten with a wooden stick or a ruler, or were forced to kneel on a pile of corn.
